**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 228**

February 14, 2006 – Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 106.13 (4) (d); and *to create* 106.13 (3m) (f) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** increasing funding for local youth apprenticeship grants for
3 programs that are targeted at providing training in the areas of health care and
4 health care technology and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) awards grants to local partnerships for the implementation and coordination of local youth apprenticeship programs under which employers are recruited to provide on-the-job training and supervision for students who are recruited to participate in those programs. Currently, \$1,100,000 in general purpose revenues (GPR) is appropriated in each of fiscal years 2005–06 and 2006–07 for those grants. This bill increases the amount appropriated for those grants by \$1,400,000 GPR in fiscal year 2006–07 for the purpose of providing grants for programs that are targeted at providing training and state-required exit testing in the areas of health care and health care technology.
