The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 38.04 (4) (am) of the statutes is amended to read: 5 38.04 (4) (am) The Except as provided in s. 38.21 (1) (a), the board shall not consider any course of study for approval under par. (a) that has not first been 6 7 approved by the district board. 8 **SECTION 2.** 38.21 of the statutes is created to read: 9 **38.21 Health care occupations.** (1) By the first day of the 60th month 10 beginning after the effective date of this subsection [revisor inserts date], the board, in cooperation with the district boards, shall do all of the following: 11

(a) Develop a curriculum for each health occupation program offered by the
 districts and ensure that each district board adopts it.

3 (b) Establish program application standards relating to testing, skill 4 requirements, academic course requirements, certification requirements, and 5 physical examinations, if any, that are applicable to each health occupation program 6 offered by the districts.

7 (2) By the first day of the 30th month beginning after the effective date of this
8 subsection [revisor inserts date], the board shall report to the legislature on the
9 progress made to develop curricula and establish program application standards
10 under sub. (1).

(3) By the first day of the 61st month beginning after the effective date of this
subsection [revisor inserts date], the board shall report to the legislature any
district board that has not adopted the required curricula or program application
standards under sub. (1).

SECTION 3. Nonstatutory provisions.

16 (1) The technical college system board shall report to the legislature on issues
affecting the technical college system board's efforts to address the statewide
shortage of health care workers by the first day of the 9th month beginning after the
effective date of this subsection.
