- 13 **3.** Page 2, line 14: after that line insert:

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## "Section 5m. Nonstatutory provisions.

- (1) The department of natural resources shall include, as part of its 2007–09 biennial budget request that it submits to the department of administration under section 16.42 of the statutes, a proposal for a program to assist in the development of a facility for the vitrification of sediments containing PCBs, as defined in section 299.45 (1) (a) of the statutes, removed from the bed of water bodies in the Fox River system as part of a remedial action required under s. 292.11 or 292.31 of the statutes or under the federal Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, 42 USC 9601 to 9675. The department shall include in the proposed program technical assistance to developers of the vitrification technology and appropriate financial assistance or incentives.".
  - **4.** Page 2, line 15: delete lines 15 to 18.
