**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 606**

September 6, 2005 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber* 77.51 (1); and *to create* 77.51 (1bm), 77.54 (30) (a) 7. and
2 77.54 (48) of the statutes; **relating to:** sales and use tax exemptions for
3 electricity used in agricultural biotechnology and for vitamins, feed
4 supplements, and hormones used on livestock.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 77.51 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 77.51 (1d).

6 **SECTION 2.** 77.51 (1bm) of the statutes is created to read:

7 77.51 (**1bm**) “Agricultural biotechnology” means the application of
8 technologies, including recombinant deoxyribonucleic acid techniques,
9 biochemistry, molecular and cellular biology, genetics, genetic engineering,
10 biological cell fusion techniques, and new bioprocesses, that use living organisms or
11 parts of organisms to produce or modify products to improve plants or animals used

1 in agriculture, develop microorganisms for specific agricultural uses, identify
2 targets for small molecule pharmaceutical development for agricultural use, or
3 transform biological systems into useful agricultural processes and products.

4 **SECTION 3.** 77.54 (30) (a) 7. of the statutes is created to read:

5 77.54 (30) (a) 7. Electricity consumed in research or product development for
6 agricultural biotechnology in this state.

7 **SECTION 4.** 77.54 (48) of the statutes is created to read:

8 77.54 (48) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use, or other
9 consumption of vitamins, feed supplements, and hormones used on farm livestock,
10 as defined in s. 95.51 (1).

11 **SECTION 5. Effective date.**

12 (1) This act takes effect on July 1, 2007.
