  - **3.** Page 1, line 3: delete "Section 1" and substitute "Section 1p".
  - **4.** Page 2, line 6: after that line insert:

## "Section 1r. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Notwithstanding section 16.27 (5) of the statutes, in fiscal year 2005–06, a household with an annual income that does not exceed 206.7 percent of the federal poverty line is eligible to receive low-income energy assistance under section 16.27 of the statutes. Notwithstanding section 16.27 (2), (3), and (6) of the statutes, the department of administration shall pay low-income energy assistance benefits under this subsection from the appropriation account under section 20.505 (1) (dm) of the statutes, as created by this act.

## SECTION 2m. Appropriation changes.

- (1) Medical Assistance reimbursement decrease. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of family services under section 20.435 (4) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2005, the dollar amount is decreased by \$63,500,000 for fiscal year 2005–06 and the dollar amount is decreased by \$100,000 for fiscal year 2006–07 to decrease funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
- (2) Transfer from General fund to Medical Assistance trust fund. There is transferred from the general fund to the Medical Assistance trust fund \$51,400,000 in fiscal year 2005–06 and \$25,300,000 in 2006–07.
