| 13 | the repeal and recreation of section 19.45 (14) (b) or (c) of the statutes or the repeal |
| 14 | of section 19.45 (14) (a) 5m. of the statutes by this act, or any part of the laws specified |
| 15 | in 2001 Wisconsin Act 109, section 9115 $(2y)$ (b), is unconstitutional, the repeal and |
| 16 | recreation of section 19.45 (14) (b) and (c) of the statutes and the repeal of section |
| 17 | 19.45 (14) (a) 5m. of the statutes by this act is void.". |
