



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 68**

January 19, 2006 – Offered by Representative BLACK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 9: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 2m.** Section 10 (1) (d) of article V of the constitution is created to read:

4 [Article V] Section 10 (1) (d) The amendment of paragraph (c) by 2005 Assembly
5 Joint Resolution 68 applies beginning on January 3, 2011.

6 **SECTION 3m. Numbering of new provision.** The new paragraph (d) of
7 subsection (1) of section 10 of article V of the constitution created in this joint
8 resolution shall be designated by the next higher open whole paragraph letter in that
9 subsection in that section in that article if, before the ratification by the people of the
10 amendment proposed in this joint resolution, any other ratified amendment has
11 created a paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section 10 of article V of the constitution
12 of this state. If one or more joint resolutions create a paragraph (d) of subsection (1)

1 of section 10 of article V simultaneously with the ratification by the people of the
2 amendment proposed in this joint resolution, the paragraphs created shall be
3 lettered and placed in a sequence so that the paragraphs created by the joint
4 resolution having the lowest enrolled joint resolution number have the letters
5 designated in that joint resolution and the paragraphs created by the other joint
6 resolutions have letters that are in the same ascending order as are the letters of the
7 enrolled joint resolutions creating the paragraphs.”.
