**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 SENATE BILL 175**

October 12, 2005 – Offered by Senator SCHULTZ.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 20.866 (2) (t) of the statutes; **relating to:** the 2005-07
2 Authorized State Building Program, granting bonding authority, and making
3 an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This substitute amendment amends the 2005-07 Authorized State Building Program to add one project at the University of Wisconsin-Platteville. The project involves the purchase and remodeling of two buildings for university housing and is financed with \$5,000,000 in new program revenue supported borrowing.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 20.866 (2) (t) of the statutes, as affected by 2005 Wisconsin Act 25,
5 is amended to read:

6 20.866 (2) (t) *University of Wisconsin; self-amortizing facilities.* From the
7 capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the board of regents of the University

1 of Wisconsin System to acquire, construct, develop, enlarge or improve university
 2 self-amortizing educational facilities and facilities to support such facilities. The
 3 state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed ~~\$1,274,517,100~~
 4 \$1,279,517,100 for this purpose. Of this amount, \$4,500,000 is allocated only for the
 5 University of Wisconsin-Madison indoor practice facility for athletic programs and
 6 only at the time that ownership of the facility is transferred to the state.

7 **SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.**

8 (1) 2005-07 STATE BUILDING PROGRAM ADDITION. In 2005 Wisconsin Act 25,
 9 section 9105 (1), the following project is added to the 2005-07 Authorized State
 10 Building Program and the appropriate totals are increased by the amount shown:

11 (a) In paragraph (h) 3., under projects financed by
 12 program revenue supported borrowing for the
 13 University of Wisconsin-Platteville:
 14 Purchase and remodeling of buildings at 300 W.
 15 Highway 151 and 825 Chestnut Street
 16 (housing) 5,000,000
