## SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2005 SENATE BILL 215

November 29, 2005 - Offered by Senator Grothman.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, line 8: delete lines 8 to 12 and substitute "other charges not otherwise included in the invoice cost of the motor vehicle fuel, plus a markup of $9.18 \%$ on the portion of that amount that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and a markup of $3.03 \%$ on any portion of that amount in excess of $\$ 1$ to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business; or the average posted terminal price at the terminal located closest to the retail station plus a markup of $9.18 \%$ on the portion of the average posted terminal price that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and a markup of $3.03 \%$ on any portion of the average terminal price in excess of $\$ 1$ to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business; whichever is greater.".
2. Page 3, line 4: delete lines 4 to 8 and substitute "invoice cost or replacement cost of the motor vehicle fuel, plus a markup of $9.18 \%$ on the portion of that amount that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and a markup of $3.03 \%$ on any portion of that amount
in excess of $\$ 1$ to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business; or the average posted terminal price at the terminal located closest to the retail station plus a markup of $9.18 \%$ on the portion of the average posted terminal price that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and a markup of $3.03 \%$ on any portion of the average terminal price in excess of $\$ 1$ to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business; whichever is greater.".
3. Page 3 , line 17: delete lines 17 to 21 and substitute "the replacement cost of the motor vehicle fuel, plus a markup of $6 \%$ on the portion of that amount that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and a markup of $3 \%$ on any portion of that amount in excess of \$1 to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business; or the average posted terminal price at the terminal located closest to the retailer plus a markup of $9.18 \%$ on the portion of the average posted terminal price that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and a markup of $3.03 \%$ on any portion of the average terminal price in excess of $\$ 1$ to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business; whichever is greater.".
4. Page 4, line 4: delete lines 4 to 6 and substitute "of the motor vehicle fuel to which shall be added a markup to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business, which markup, in the absence of proof of a lesser cost, shall be $3 \%$ on the portion of the cost to the retailer as set forth in this subd. 1 m . d. that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and $1 \%$ on any portion of the cost to retailer in excess of $\$ 1 . "$.
5. Page 4, line 15: delete lines 15 to 17 and substitute "the motor vehicle fuel to which shall be added a markup to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business, which markup, in the absence of proof of a lesser cost, shall be $3 \%$ on the portion of the cost to the retailer as set forth in this subd. 1 m . e. that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and $1 \%$ on any portion of the cost to retailer in excess of $\$ 1 . "$.
6. Page 4 , line 25: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with page 5, line 2 and substitute "the motor vehicle fuel to which shall be added a markup to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business, which markup, in the absence of proof of a lesser cost, shall be $3 \%$ on the portion of the cost to the wholesaler as set forth in this subdivision that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and $1 \%$ on any portion of the cost to wholesaler in excess of $\$ 1 . "$.
7. Page 5, line 11: delete lines 11 to 14 and substitute "the replacement cost of the motor vehicle fuel to which shall be added a markup to cover a proportionate part of the cost of doing business, which markup, in the absence of proof of a lesser cost, shall be $3 \%$ on the portion of the cost to the wholesaler as set forth in this subdivision that is equal to or less than $\$ 1$ and $1 \%$ on any portion of the cost to wholesaler in excess of $\$ 1 . "$.
