



**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 SENATE BILL 372**

February 10, 2006 – Offered by Senator KANAVAS.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** a grant for a biomedical technology alliance in southeastern
2 Wisconsin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do
enact as follows:*

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) BIOMEDICAL TECHNOLOGY ALLIANCE; GRANT. Notwithstanding section 560.61
5 of the statutes, the department of commerce shall, from the appropriation under
6 section 20.143 (1) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 2005 Wisconsin Act 25, make a
7 grant of \$2,000,000 in the 2006–07 fiscal year to the Board of Regents of the
8 University of Wisconsin System to supplement moneys granted under 2005
9 Wisconsin Act 25, section 9108 (3k). No moneys may be expended under this
10 subsection unless the Board of Regents secures private, local, or federal matching
11 funds that are equal to 100 percent of the moneys to be expended. The department

1 shall ensure that moneys expended under this subsection cover only research and
2 not administrative costs and that no moneys are expended on investors, consultants,
3 or on nonprofit or economic development organizations.

4 (2) GRANT LIMITATIONS. The proceeds of the grant under subsection (1) may not
5 be used to do any of the following:

6 (a) Conduct research that involves the destruction of a human embryo or uses
7 cells or tissues derived from the destruction of a human embryo that was destroyed
8 after August 9, 2001.

9 (b) Create a human embryo for research purposes.

10 (c) Clone a human embryo for any purpose.

11 (3) RECONCILIATION PROVISION. This act is void unless 2005 Wisconsin Act ...
12 (Senate Bill) (LRB-4384/1) is enacted into law in the same form in which it is
13 introduced.
