## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2005 SENATE BILL 61

May 4, 2006 - Offered by Representative MUSSER.

1 AN ACT to amend 341.305 (2) (a) of the statutes; relating to: consecutive 2 monthly registration of certain vehicles used exclusively to transport calcium 3 chloride liquid or a weight transfer machine for truck or tractor pulling 4 competitions or events.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, certain types of vehicles may be registered for a period of consecutive months instead of for an annual or quarterly registration period. Consecutive monthly registration is for a minimum of three months, plus as many additional consecutive months as requested. Vehicles that may be registered on a consecutive monthly basis include motor trucks, trailers, and truck tractors used exclusively to transport concrete pipe or block, recycled metal salvage materials, logs or pulpwood, dirt, fill, or aggregates, or fresh milk. The fee for this type of registration is one-twelfth of the regular annual fee for the vehicle times the number of months for which the vehicle will be registered, plus a \$15 application charge.

This substitute amendment permits consecutive monthly registration of a motor truck, trailer, or truck tractor used exclusively to transport calcium chloride

liquid or a weight transfer machine for truck or tractor pulling competitions or events.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 341.305 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
2	341.305 (2) (a) A motor truck or a trailer or a truck tractor used exclusively to
3	transport concrete pipe or block and related materials, <u>calcium chloride liquid, a</u>
4	weight transfer machine for purposes associated with truck or tractor pulling
5	<u>competitions or events</u> , recycled metal salvage materials, logs or pulpwood, dirt, fill
6	or aggregates, or fresh milk, or to transport perishable fresh fruits or vegetables for
7	canning, freezing, dehydrating or storage prior to processing, including return of
8	waste, or to transport petroleum products.
9	SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

- 10 (1) This act first applies to vehicles registered by the department of
  11 transportation on the effective date of this subsection.
