Page 32, line 24: after "void." insert "If the commission determines that a municipal regulation that was in effect on January 1, 2007, and immediately prior to the effective date of this subsection [revisor inserts date], or that a community standard, as demonstrated through consistent practice and custom in the municipality, that was in effect on January 1, 2007, and immediately prior to the effective date of this subsection [revisor inserts date], is substantially the same as the municipal regulation complained of, there is a rebuttable presumption that the latter regulation is reasonable. A municipal regulation is unreasonable if it has the effect of creating a moratorium on the placement of company lines or systems

- 1 under sub. (1r) or on the entrance into the municipality of a video service provider,
- as defined in s. 66.0420 (2) (zg), or is inconsistent with the purposes of s. 66.0420.".
