ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4, TO SENATE AMENDMENT 14, TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 207

December 11, 2007 – Offered by Representatives Molepske, Smith, Hilgenberg, Vruwink, Hintz, Hixson, Krusick and Hebl.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 2: delete lines 2 to 10 and substitute:
3	"1c. Page 13, line 9: delete lines 9 to 11 and substitute "cable operators are
4	required to provide channel capacity in the municipality, and the percentage of".
5	1g. Page 18, line 21: delete lines 21 and 22 and substitute "any PEG channel
6	until the 90th day after the municipality provides such".
7	1n. Page 21, line 15: delete lines 15 to 17 and substitute "percentage of the video
8	service provider's gross receipts that is specified in par. (b). A video service provider
9	shall remit the fee to the municipality no later than".
10	1r. Page 23, line 23: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
11	with page 25, line 4, and substitute:

"(em) PEG channel support fee. A municipality may, by ordinance, for the 1 $\mathbf{2}$ purpose of supporting PEG channels, require an interim cable operator or video 3 service provider to pay the municipality a fee equal to no more than 1 percent of the video service provider's annual gross receipts. If an interim cable operator pays a 4 $\mathbf{5}$ franchise fee to a municipality, the interim cable operator shall pay any fee required 6 under this paragraph at the time that the interim cable operator pays the franchise 7 fee to the municipality. A video service provider shall pay a fee required under this 8 paragraph at the time that the video service provider pays a video service provider 9 fee to the municipality.".

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10 1w. Page 25, line 6: delete lines 6 and 7 and substitute "related to a video service
provider fee and any PEG channel support fee required under par. (em) as a separate
line item".".
