## SENATE AMENDMENT 8, TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 207

November 8, 2007 - Offered by Senators Vinehout, Miller, Risser, Robson, Erpenbach, Lassa and Kreitlow.

At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:

1. Page 21, line 6: delete that line and substitute:
"(6) Public use connections and institutional networks. (a) Public use connections. 1. Except as provided in subd. 3., each video service provider shall offer free basic video service or its equivalent to, and shall without charge install one activated outlet with standard installation video service at, each elementary and secondary public school, including a charter school, each municipal building, and each public library in its video franchise area.
2. The requirements under subd. 1 . shall apply to a video service provider at the time that its video service is available on the section of its video service network that passes the public school, municipal building, or public library.
3. For the purpose of avoiding duplicative installations, video service providers whose video service is available to the same public school, municipal building, or
public library shall negotiate among themselves to determine which video service provider will comply with the requirements under subd. 1. with respect to the public school, municipal building, or public library. If the video service providers cannot reach agreement as to who will comply with such requirements, the governing body of the municipality or its designee shall confer with the video service providers and resolve the issue in a reasonable manner.
(b) Institutional networks. Notwithstanding any franchise, ordinance, or".
4. Page 21, line 10: after "network" insert "that is in addition to the institutional network or equivalent capacity that is required on the effective date of this paragraph .... [revisor inserts date]".
