## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 354

October 4, 2007 - Offered by Representative MUSSER.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 3: after "Commission" insert "; corrections classification

3 specialists employed by the Department of Corrections who perform duties related
4 to sexually violent person commitments;".

**2.** Page 3, line 14: after that line insert:

**"SECTION 2dm.** 40.02 (17) (pm) of the statutes is created to read:

40.02 (17) (pm) Notwithstanding par. (d), each participant who is a corrections classification specialist employed by the department of corrections and who performs duties related to ch. 980 on or after the effective date of this paragraph .... [revisor inserts date], shall be granted creditable service as a protective occupation participant for all covered service while a classification specialist employed by the department of corrections and performing duties related to ch. 980 that was earned on or after the effective date of this paragraph .... [revisor inserts date], but may not 2007 – 2008 Legislature

be granted creditable service as a protective occupation participant for any covered
service while a corrections classification specialist employed by the department of
corrections and performing duties related to ch. 980 that was earned before the
effective date of this paragraph .... [revisor inserts date], unless that service was
earned while the participant was classified under sub. (48) (a) and s. 40.06 (1) (d) as
a protective occupation participant.".

**3.** Page 4, line 14: after that line insert:

8 "SECTION 4dm. 40.02 (48) (bdp) of the statutes is created to read:

9 40.02 (48) (bdp) "Protective occupation participant" includes any participant 10 who is a corrections classification specialist employed by the department of 11 corrections and who performs duties related to ch. 980 if the participant's employer 12classifies the participant as a protective occupation participant and the department 13 receives notification of the participant's name as provided in s. 40.06 (1) (d) and (dm). 14Notwithstanding par. (a), an employer shall classify a participant who is a 15corrections classification specialist employed by the department of corrections and 16 who performs duties related to ch. 980 as a protective occupation participant without 17making a determination that the principal duties of the participant involve active 18 law enforcement or active fire suppression or prevention.".

- **4.** Page 4, line 18: after "(bd)," insert "(bdp),".
- 20 **5.** Page 5, line 8: after that line insert:

21 "SECTION 6dm. 40.65 (4vs) of the statutes is created to read:

40.65 (**4vs**) A participant who is a corrections classification specialist employed by the department of corrections and who performs duties related to ch. 980, who becomes a protective occupation participant on or after the effective date of this 1 subsection .... [revisor inserts date], is not entitled to a duty disability benefit under

this section for an injury or disease occurring before the effective date of this
subsection .... [revisor inserts date].".
