**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 531**

1     **AN ACT to amend** 109.03 (1) (e) of the statutes; **relating to:** the frequency of  
2             wage payments to part-time fire fighters and emergency medical technicians  
3             who are members of a volunteer fire department or emergency medical services  
4             program maintained by a public organization or who are members of a private,  
5             nonprofit volunteer fire company.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Current law generally requires an employer to pay an employee his or her wages by no later than 31 days after the date on which the wages are earned. Current law, however, permits a volunteer fire fighter or a volunteer emergency medical technician, by agreement with the entity employing the volunteer, to be paid semiannually or annually. This substitute amendment permits a part-time fire fighter or a part-time emergency medical technician who is a member of a volunteer fire department or emergency medical services program maintained by a county, city, village, or town or of a private, nonprofit volunteer fire company, by agreement with
