1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2	amendment 1, as follows:
3	${f 1.}$ Page 1, line 8: after "service," insert "the collection and disposal of
4	prescription drugs,".
5	2. Page 2, line 24: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 1r. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place,
7	insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

10	(2) AIR AND WASTE
11	(es) Solid waste management — pre-
12	scription drug collection SEG C \$1,000,000 -0-

2007 – 2008 Legislature – 2 –

1	SECTION 1t. 20.370 (2) (es) of the statutes is created to read:
2	20.370 (2) (es) Solid waste management — prescription drug collection. From
3	the recycling fund, as a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule for
4	the collection and disposal of prescription drugs under s. 299.41.".
5	3. Page 3, line 21: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 4m. 299.41 of the statutes is created to read:
7	299.41 Prescription drug collection and disposal. The department shall
8	expend funds appropriated under s. 20.370 (2) (es) for the collection and proper
9	disposal of unused prescription drugs.".
10	4. Page 10, line 6: delete "\$1,500,000" and substitute "\$500,000".
11	5. Page 11, line 15: after that line insert:
12	"SECTION 9400. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after
13	publication, except as follows:
14	(1) Prescription drug collection. The treatment of sections 20.005 (3)
15	(schedule), 20.370 $\left(2\right)$ (es) and 299.41 of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2007, or
16	on the day after publication of the biennial budget act, whichever is later.".
