 - **2.** Page 1, line 4: before that line insert:
- 4 "Section 1g. 23.119 of the statutes is created to read:
- 5 **23.119 Consent to use certain off-highway vehicles.** (1) In this section:
- 6 (a) "All-terrain vehicle" has the meaning given in s. 340.01 (2g).
- 7 (b) "Off-highway vehicle" means a motor-driven craft or vehicle principally
 8 manufactured for off-highway use but does not include a snowmobile or all terrain
 9 vehicle.
- 10 (c) "Snowmobile" has the meaning given in s. 340.01 (58a).

(2) No person may operate an off-highway vehicle on private property withou
the consent of the owner of the property.

- (3) No person may operate an off-highway vehicle on public property that is posted as closed to the operation of off-highway vehicles or on which the operation of an off-highway vehicle is prohibited by law.".
 - **3.** Page 1, line 4: delete "1" and substitute "1r".
 - **4.** Page 1, line 6: after that line insert:

"Section 1t. 350.10 (1) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

350.10 (1) (f) On the private property of another without the consent of the owner or lessee. Failure to post private property does not imply consent for snowmobile use. Any other motor–driven craft or vehicle principally manufactured for off–highway use shall at all times have the consent of the owner before operation of such craft or vehicle on private lands.".
