**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2009 SENATE BILL 567**

March 22, 2010 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES AND WORKFORCE
DEVELOPMENT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 10: delete that line and substitute “providers; requiring the
exercise of rule-making authority; and making an appropriation.”.

3 **2.** Page 11, line 1: before that line insert:

4 **“SECTION 14p. Nonstatutory provisions.**

5 (1) PERFORMANCE-BASED CONTRACTING SYSTEM. The authorized FTE positions for
6 the department of children and families are increased by 0.63 FED positions, to be
7 funded from the appropriation under section 20.437 (1) (n) of the statutes, for the
8 performance of services associated with the implementation of the
9 performance-based contracting system under section 49.343 (6) of the statutes, as
10 created by this act.

11 (2) REQUIRED GENERAL FUND BALANCE. Section 20.003 (4) of the statutes does not
12 apply to the action of the legislature in enacting this act.

1 **SECTION 14r. Fiscal changes.**

2 (1) PERFORMANCE-BASED CONTRACTING SYSTEM. In the schedule under section
3 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of children and
4 families under section 20.437 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2009,
5 the dollar amount is increased by \$200,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal
6 biennium in which this subsection takes effect to increase the authorized FTE
7 positions for the department by 2.37 GPR positions for the performance of services
8 associated with the implementation of the performance-based contracting system
9 under section 49.343 (6) of the statutes, as created by this act.”
