**SENATE AMENDMENT 3,  
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE BILL 6**

February 2, 2011 – Offered by Senators TAYLOR, S. COGGS, LASSA, MILLER, RISSER, T. CULLEN, C. LARSON, HOLPERIN and VINEHOUT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 22, line 10: after that line insert:

3 “(4) In developing and implementing programs under this section, the board  
4 shall have the following goals:

5 (a) That not less than 50 percent of those programs are directed to, and not less  
6 than 50 percent of all grants, loans, or other incentives are awarded to, small  
7 businesses.

8 (b) That not less than 5 percent of those programs are directed to, and not less  
9 than 5 percent of all grants, loans, or other incentives are awarded to, minority  
10 businesses certified by the department of commerce under s. 560.036.
