5	"Section 1d. 29.089 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:
6	29.089 (title) Hunting, fishing, and trapping on land in state parks and
7	state fish hatcheries.
8	Section 1f. 29.089 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
9	29.089 (1) Except as provided in sub. (3), no No person may hunt or trap on land
10	located in state parks or state fish hatcheries.
11	Section 1j. 29.089 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

1	29.089 (1m) (a) Except as provided in par. (b), state parks shall be open to
2	hunting, fishing, and trapping by persons who hold the appropriate approvals
3	required under this chapter.
4	(b) The department may prohibit hunting, fishing, or trapping in a state park
5	or a portion of a state park if the natural resources board determines that prohibiting
6	that activity is necessary to protect public safety or to protect a unique animal or
7	plant community. A determination to prohibit hunting, fishing, or trapping in a state
8	park or a portion of a state park requires 4 or more members of the natural resources
9	board to concur in that determination.
10	Section 1m. 29.089 (2) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 2011 Wisconsin
11	Act 35, is amended to read:
12	29.089 (2) (intro.) Except as provided in sub. (3), no No person may have in his
13	or her possession or under his or her control a firearm on land located in state parks
14	or state fish hatcheries unless the firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying
15	case. This subsection does not apply to any of the following:
16	Section 1p. 29.089 (3) of the statutes is repealed.".
17	3. Page 10, line 23: after that line insert:
18	"(3) The treatment of section 29.089 (title), (1), (1m), (2) (intro.), and (3) of the
19	statutes takes effect on January 1, 2013.".
