**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,  
TO ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 558**

March 15, 2012 - Offered by Representative KRUSICK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 14: after that line insert:

3 "4. In each school in the school district, prominently display the Measures of  
4 Academic Progress growth assessments and the growth assessments for any other  
5 nationally recognized assessments administered during the school year to pupils  
6 attending the school on the wall of the school within 30 days of receiving scores from  
7 the assessment company. The display under this subdivision shall provide mean  
8 average class growth for each grade and class in the school to which the assessments  
9 were administered in the school year in each of the following subjects:

10 a. Reading.

11 b. Language arts.

1 c. Math.

2 d. Science.

3 e. Social studies.

4 **SECTION 21ar.** 118.30 (1r) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

5 118.30 (1r) (c) To the extent permitted under 20 USC 1232g and 43 CFR part  
6 99, beginning in the 2012-13 school year, do all of the following:

7 1. a. Except as provided in subd. 1. b., report the scores from any examinations  
8 required to be administered under this subsection or sub. (6) for the 5 preceding  
9 school years on the school's Internet site as soon as the information becomes  
10 available and no later than 30 days after receiving scores from the testing company.  
11 Scores under this subdivision shall be reported by grade and class and shall include  
12 the total number of questions, the number and percentage of questions each pupil  
13 answered correctly, the number of questions each pupil answered incorrectly, the  
14 mean percentile for the class, the mean average percentile distributions, the mean  
15 average scores, and the mean percentage distributions for the examination as a  
16 whole and for each of the following topics and subtopics: reading, including  
17 determining meaning, understanding texts, analyzing texts, and evaluating and  
18 extending texts; mathematics, including processing number operations, geometry,  
19 measurement, statistics and probability, and algebraic relationships; science; social  
20 studies; and any other topic or subtopic included in the examination.

21 b. The operator of a charter school is not required to report the information  
22 under subd. 1. a. if the number of pupils in a category is insufficient to yield  
23 statistically reliable information or the results would reveal personally identifiable  
24 information about an individual pupil.

1           2. Provide the department with an electronic copy of the information described  
2 in subd. 1.

3           3. Provide the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in the school district  
4 with a paper copy of the information described in subd. 1. The information shall be  
5 printed in at least 12-point type and provided as soon as it becomes available and  
6 no later than 30 days after receiving scores from the testing company.

7           4. Prominently display the Measures of Academic Progress growth  
8 assessments and the growth assessments for any other nationally recognized  
9 assessments administered during the school year to pupils attending the charter  
10 school on the wall of the school within 30 days of receiving scores from the assessment  
11 company. The display under this subdivision shall provide mean average class  
12 growth for each grade and class in the school to which the assessments were  
13 administered in the school year in each of the following subjects:

14           a. Reading.

15           b. Language arts.

16           c. Math.

17           d. Science.

18           e. Social studies.”.

19           **2.** Page 7, line 13: after that line insert:

20           “6. Prominently display the Measures of Academic Progress growth  
21 assessments and the growth assessments for any other nationally recognized  
22 assessments administered during the school year to pupils attending the private  
23 school on the wall of the private school within 30 days of receiving scores from the  
24 assessment company. The display under this subdivision shall provide mean

1 average class growth for each grade and class in the school to which the assessments  
2 were administered in the school year in each of the following subjects:

- 3 a. Reading.
- 4 b. Language arts.
- 5 c. Math.
- 6 d. Science.
- 7 e. Social studies.”.

8 **3.** Page 14, line 22: after that line insert:

9 “6. Prominently display the Measures of Academic Progress growth  
10 assessments and the growth assessments for any other nationally recognized  
11 assessments administered during the school year to pupils attending the private  
12 school on the wall of the private school within 30 days of receiving scores from the  
13 assessment company. The display under this subdivision shall provide mean  
14 average class growth for each grade and class in the school to which the assessments  
15 were administered in the school year in each of the following subjects:

- 16 a. Reading.
- 17 b. Language arts.
- 18 c. Math.
- 19 d. Science.
- 20 e. Social studies.”.
