## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 20, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2, TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7

May 11, 2011 - Offered by Representatives Bewley, Young, Hebl and E. Coggs.

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

1. Page 27, line 19: after that line insert:

"Section 43m. 6.76 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

6.76 (1m) Any person who is entitled to vote in an election is entitled to be absent from work for not more than 3 successive hours during the period specified in s. 6.97 (3) (b) if the person casts a provisional ballot or the person's absentee ballot is considered to be provisional under s. 6.97 at the election because the person did not present proof of identification or enclose a copy of proof of identification when voting and the person needs time to obtain proof of identification and to provide the proof to the municipal clerk. The person shall provide notice to the affected employer

- 1 before his or her intended absence and the employer may designate the time for the
- absence.".
