## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 30, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2, TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7

May 11, 2011 - Offered by Representatives Hulsey, Roys, Young and E. Coggs.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 8, line 1: before that line insert:
3	"Section 1d. 5.02 (6e) of the statutes is created to read:
4	5.02 (6e) "Homeless person" means an individual who lacks a fixed, regular
5	and adequate nighttime residence and who has a nighttime residence that is one of
6	the following:
7	(a) A supervised publicly or privately operated shelter designed to provide
8	temporary living accommodations.
9	(b) An institution that provides a temporary residence for individuals intended

(c) A public or private place not designed for, or ordinarily used as, a regular

- 2. Page 8, line 1: delete "Section 1" and substitute "Section 1m".
- **3.** Page 9, line 8: after that line insert:
- "(g) If an individual is a homeless person and not able to present any of the documents specified in pars. (a) to (f), an affidavit in the form prescribed by the board specifying the individual's name and address, affirming the individual's identity and stating that this is the address of the individual's residence."
  - **4.** Page 59, line 7: after that line insert:
  - "Section 100g. 7.51 (5) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:
- 7.51 **(5)** (a) 4. The inspectors shall immediately deliver all ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes, and affidavits to the municipal clerk.

**SECTION 100r.** 7.51 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

7.51 (5) (b) The municipal clerk shall deliver all ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes relating to a school district election to the school district clerk by 4 p.m. on the day following each such election. The municipal clerk shall deliver the ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes for his or her municipality relating to any county, technical college district, state, or national election to the county clerk no later than 4 p.m. on the day following each such election or, in municipalities where absentee ballots are canvassed under s. 7.52, by 4 p.m. on the 2nd day following each such election, and no later than 4 p.m. on the day after receiving any corrected returns under s. 6.221 (6) (b). The person delivering the returns shall be paid out of the municipal treasury. Each clerk shall retain ballots, statements, tally sheets, or envelopes, and affidavits received by the clerk until destruction is authorized under s. 7.23 (1).".
