ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,

TO 2011 SENATE BILL 93

June 21, 2011 – Offered by Representatives Pasch, D. Cullen, Hintz, Roys, Young, Zamarripa, Turner, Clark, Hulsey, Pope-Roberts, Pocan, Ringhand, Bewley, Seidel, Berceau and Richards.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2	amendment 2, as follows:
3	1 . Page 2, line 11: after "officers;" insert "purchasing a firearm for a person who
4	is prohibited from possessing a firearm;".
5	2. Page 43, line 19: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 49g. 939.6185 of the statutes is created to read:
7	939.6185 Mandatory minimum sentence for illegally carrying a
8	concealed weapon if previously convicted of violent felony. If a person is
9	convicted of a violation of s. 941.23 $\left(2d\right)$ and the person has been previously convicted
10	of a violent offense, as defined in s. 301.048 (2) (bm), the court shall impose a
11	bifurcated sentence under s. 973.01. The term of confinement in prison portion of the
12	bifurcated sentence shall be at least 3 years. Otherwise the penalties for the crime

1	SECTION 49h. 939.632 (1) (e) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:
2	939.632 (1) (e) 3. Any misdemeanor under s. 940.19 (1), 940.225 (3m), 940.32
3	(2), 940.42, 940.44, 941.20 (1), 941.23 (2), 941.235, 941.24 or 941.38 (3).".
4	3. Page 43, line 22: delete "Any" and substitute "Any <u>Except as provided in</u>
5	<u>sub. (2d), any</u> ".
6	4. Page 46, line 12: after that line insert:
7	"SECTION 55g. 941.23 (2d) of the statutes is created to read:
8	941.23 (2d) A person who violates sub. (2), who is prohibited from possessing
9	a firearm under s. 941.29 or who is a repeater as defined in s. 939.62 (2) is guilty of
10	a Class H felony.".
11	5. Page 49, line 4: after that line insert:
12	"SECTION 64g. 941.2905 of the statutes is created to read:
13	941.2905 Straw purchase of firearm. (1) Whoever purchases a firearm for
14	a person knowing that the person is prohibited from possessing a firearm under s.
15	941.29 is guilty of a Class G felony.
16	(2) A person who possesses a firearm in violation of s. 941.29 (2) is guilty of a
17	Class F felony if he or she knows that another person purchased the firearm for the
18	person.".
