**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2011 SENATE BILL 93**

June 13, 2011 – Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 15: before “All” insert “The amounts in the schedule to provide  
3 services under s. 175.60.”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 17: delete “to provide services under s. 175.60” and substitute  
5 “shall be credited to this appropriation”.

6 **3.** Page 59, line 24: after that line insert:

7 **“SECTION 100h. Fiscal changes.**

8 (1m) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the  
9 appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455 (2) (gs) of the  
10 statutes, as affected by the acts of 2011, the dollar amount is increased by \$62,300  
11 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect to  
12 increase the authorized FTE positions by 1.0 PR position. In the schedule under

1 section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of justice  
2 under section 20.455 (2) (gs) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2011, the dollar  
3 amount is increased by \$62,300 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in  
4 which this subsection takes effect to increase the authorized FTE positions by 1.0 PR  
5 position.

6 (2m) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the  
7 appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455 (2) (gs) of the  
8 statutes, as affected by the acts of 2011, the dollar amount is increased by \$174,400  
9 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect to  
10 fund 10.0 LTE positions for 6 months.

11 (3m) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the  
12 appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455 (2) (gs) of the  
13 statutes, as affected by the acts of 2011, the dollar amount is increased by \$77,100  
14 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect for  
15 the purpose of providing supplies and services.”.

16 **4.** Page 60, line 5: after that line insert:

17 “(2c) The treatment of section 20.455 (2) (gs) of the statutes and SECTION 100h  
18 of this act take effect on July 1, 2011.”.
