## SENATE AMENDMENT 9, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 40

June 20, 2013 - Offered by Senators Lehman, Wirch, Risser, T. Cullen, Miller, Vinehout, L. Taylor, Shilling, Harris, Erpenbach, Hansen, Lassa and C. Larson.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute amendment 1, as follows:

- 1. Page 139, line 1: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by \$180,000,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$412,000,000 to increase funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
- **2.** Page 139, line 7: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by \$8,500,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$8,500,000 to increase funding for special education aid.
- **3.** Page 139, line 10: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by \$1,500,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$1,500,000 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
  - **4.** Page 1024, line 5: substitute "\$275" for "\$75".

- **6.** Page 1024, line 17: substitute "\$275" for "\$75".
- **7.** Page 1024, line 23: after that line insert:
  - "Section 1893si. 121.91 (2m) (i) 1g. and 1r. of the statutes are created to read:
- 121.91 **(2m)** (i) 1g. Multiply the amount of the revenue increase per pupil allowed under this subsection for the previous school year by the sum of 1.0 plus the allowable rate of increase under s. 73.0305 expressed as a decimal.
  - 1r. Add the result under subd. 1. to the result under subd. 1g.
- 10 **Section 1893sic.** 121.91 (2m) (i) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
- 11 121.91 (2m) (i) 2. Multiply the result under subd. 1. 1r. by the average of the number of pupils enrolled in the current and the 2 preceding school years.".
  - **8.** Page 1025, line 13: delete "make no adjustment" and substitute "make no adjustment add the result under par. (i) 1g.".
  - **9.** Page 1026, line 4: delete "make no adjustment" and substitute "make no adjustment add the result under par. (i) 1g.".
    - **10.** Page 1026, line 13: after that line insert:
- 18 "Section 1893stm. 121.91 (4) (L) of the statutes is created to read:
  - 121.91 (4) (L) 1. In this paragraph, "local law enforcement agency" means a governmental unit of one or more persons employed full time by a city, town, village, or county in this state for the purpose of preventing and detecting crime and enforcing state laws or local ordinances, employees of which unit are authorized to make arrests for crimes while acting within the scope of their authority.

- 2. The limit otherwise applicable to a school district under sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to \$100 times the number of pupils enrolled in the school district or \$40,000, whichever is greater, if the school board adopts a resolution to do so, the school board and a local law enforcement agency jointly develop a school safety plan that specifies the purposes of the additional revenue, the school safety plan is consistent with the school safety plan required under s. 118.07 (4), and the school board submits the school safety plan to the department.
- 3. A school district may use the excess revenue under this paragraph to purchase school safety equipment, fund the compensation costs of security officers, or for school safety expenditures consistent with the school safety plan required under s. 118.07 (4). Any additional revenue received by a school district under this paragraph shall not be included in the base for determining the school district's limit under sub. (2m) for the following school year."
  - **11.** Page 1027, line 21: delete "(o), and" and substitute "(o), and (L)".
- **12.** Page 1373, line 7: after that line insert:

"(8q) Revenue Limit adjustments. The treatment of section 121.91 (4) (L) of the statutes first applies to the calculation of a school district's revenue limit for the 2013–14 school year.".
