**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 703**

February 10, 2014 – Offered by Representative PETRYK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 19: after that line insert:

3 “(am) A person who does not qualify for an exemption in par. (a) may possess,
4 import into this state, sell, or transfer dangerous exotic animals if all of the following
5 apply:

6 1. The person possesses the dangerous exotic animals in a county with a
7 population of 50,000 or less.

8 2. The person holds a Class C license as an exhibitor under the federal Animal
9 Welfare Act, 7 USC 2131 to 2159, on the effective date of this subdivision [LRB
10 inserts date], and has not been cited by the federal department of agriculture for
11 exhibiting without a license.

1 3. The person does not possess more dangerous exotic animals than the number
2 that the person possessed on the effective date of this subdivision [LRB inserts
3 date].

4 4. One of the following applies to each dangerous exotic animal possessed by
5 the person:

6 a. The dangerous exotic animal is not housed with dangerous exotic animals
7 of the opposite sex.

8 b. The dangerous exotic animal is beyond reproductive age.

9 c. A chemical contraceptive is administered to the dangerous exotic animal.

10 d. The dangerous exotic animal has been surgically altered to prevent
11 reproduction.

12 e. The dangerous exotic animal is unable to reproduce due to a permanent or
13 chronic health condition.

14 5. The person annually obtains, and maintains, a signed statement from a
15 veterinarian showing compliance with subd. 4.”.

16 **2.** Page 6, line 22: after “(a)” insert “or (am)”.

17 **3.** Page 6, line 24: after that line insert:

18 “1m. One of the following applies to each dangerous exotic animal possessed
19 by the person:

20 a. The dangerous exotic animal is not housed with dangerous exotic animals
21 of the opposite sex.

22 b. The dangerous exotic animal is beyond reproductive age.

23 c. A chemical contraceptive is administered to the dangerous exotic animal.

1 d. The dangerous exotic animal has been surgically altered to prevent
2 reproduction.

3 e. The dangerous exotic animal is unable to reproduce due to a permanent or
4 chronic health condition.

5 1s. The person annually obtains a signed statement from a veterinarian
6 showing compliance with subd. 1m.”.

7 **4.** Page 7, line 1: after “(4)” insert “, provides the statement under subd. 1s.
8 when registering the animal,”.
