## SENATE AMENDMENT 5, TO SENATE BILL 205

June 10, 2013 – Offered by JOINT LEGISLATIVE AUDIT COMMITTEE.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 14, line 4: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 32g. 238.02 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	238.02 (3) A chief executive officer shall be nominated by the governor, and
5	with the advice and consent of the senate appointed by the board, to serve at the
6	pleasure of the <del>governor</del> <u>board</u> . The board may delegate to the chief executive officer
7	any powers and duties the board considers proper <u>, except any power to appoint or</u>
8	terminate the employment of any executive employee of the corporation. The chief
9	executive officer shall receive such compensation as may be determined by the board.
10	<b>SECTION 32r.</b> 238.02 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:
11	238.02 (4) All powers and duties assigned to the corporation under this chapter
12	shall be exercised or carried out by the board, unless the board delegates the power
13	or duty to an employee of the corporation. <u>The board may not delegate to an employee</u>

of the corporation any power to appoint or terminate the employment of any
executive employee of the corporation.".
