SENATE AMENDMENT 3, TO SENATE BILL 394

January 27, 2014 – Offered by Senator LASEE.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	${f 1.}$ Page 47, line 16: substitute "easements, temporary trails" for "temporary
3	trails, easements".
4	${f 2}_{f \cdot}$ Page 47, line 19: delete lines 19 to 23 and substitute:
5	"SECTION 128e. 443.14 (8) (intro.) of the statutes is repealed.
6	SECTION 128m. 443.14 (8) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 443.14 (8) and
7	amended to read:
8	443.14 (8) An employee of a <u>professional</u> land surveyor registered in this state
9	or authorized to practice under a permit, while working doing surveying work under
10	the supervision of the employer. <u>Such exempt, if the</u> employee shall is not be in
11	responsible charge of <u>the practice of professional</u> land surveying.".
12	3. Page 48, line 1: delete lines 1 to 4 and substitute:
13	"SECTION 131e. 443.14 (8) (d) of the statutes is repealed.

1	SECTION 131m. 443.14 (8m) of the statutes is created to read:
2	443.14 (8m) (a) Subject to par. (b), an employee or contractor of any of the
3	following while engaged in land surveying is exempt from the provisions of this
4	chapter:
5	1. The provider of a broadcast service, as defined in s. 196.01 (1m).
6	2. The provider of a cable service, as defined in s. 196.01 (1p).
7	3. A commercial mobile radio service provider, as defined in s. 196.01 (2g).
8	4. A public utility, as defined in s. 196.01 (5).
9	5. A telecommunications provider, as defined in s. 196.01 (8p).
10	6. A video service provider, as defined in s. 196.01 (12r).
11	7. A cooperative association organized under ch. 185 for the purpose of
12	producing or furnishing heat, light, power, or water to its members only.
13	(b) The exemption under par. (a) applies only if the employee or contractor is
14	engaged in services described in s. 443.01 (6s) (a) 3., (c), (d), or (f) for or on behalf of
15	the provider or cooperative.".
