**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 11,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 751**

February 9, 2016 - Offered by Representative POPE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 7, line 15: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 19c.** 118.60 (2) (a) 1. a. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin  
4 Act 55, is amended to read:

5 118.60 (2) (a) 1. a. Except as provided in ~~par. (bm)~~ subd. 1. am., the pupil is a  
6 member of a family that has a total family income that does not exceed an amount  
7 equal to 3.0 times the poverty level determined in accordance with criteria  
8 established by the director of the federal office of management and budget. In this  
9 subdivision and sub. (3m), family income includes income of the pupil's parents or  
10 legal guardians. Except as provided in subd. 1. c., the family income of the pupil shall  
11 be verified as provided in subd. 1. b. A pupil attending a private school under this  
12 section whose family income increases above the income level in this subd. 1. a. may  
13 continue to attend a private school under this section.

1           **SECTION 19g.** 118.60 (2) (a) 1. am. of the statutes is created to read:

2           118.60 (2) (a) 1. am. Beginning in the 2016-17 school year, the pupil is a  
3 member of a family that has a total family income that does not exceed an amount  
4 equal to 1.85 times the poverty level determined in accordance with criteria  
5 established by the director of the federal office of management and budget. The  
6 family income of the pupil shall be verified as provided in subd. 1. b. A pupil  
7 attending a private school under this section whose family income increases above  
8 the income level in this subd. 1. am. may continue to attend a private school under  
9 this section.

10           **SECTION 19n.** 118.60 (3) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

11           118.60 (3) (c) If a participating private school rejects an applicant who resides  
12 in a school district, other than an eligible school district or a 1st class city school  
13 district, because the private school has too few available spaces, the applicant may  
14 transfer his or her application to a participating private school that has space  
15 available. An applicant rejected under this paragraph may, subject to sub. (2) (a) 1.  
16 am. and (be) ~~and (bm)~~, be admitted to a private school participating in the program  
17 under this section for the following school year.

18           **SECTION 19r.** 119.23 (2) (a) 1. a. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin  
19 Act 55, is amended to read:

20           119.23 (2) (a) 1. a. ~~The~~ Except as provided in subd. 1. am., the pupil is a member  
21 of a family that has a total family income that does not exceed an amount equal to  
22 3.0 times the poverty level determined in accordance with criteria established by the  
23 director of the federal office of management and budget. In this subdivision and sub.  
24 (3m), family income includes income of the pupil's parents or legal guardians. Except  
25 as provided in subd. 1. d., the family income of the pupil shall be verified as provided

1 in subd. 1. b. A pupil attending a private school under this section whose family  
2 income increases above the income level in this subd. 1. a., including a pupil who  
3 attended a private school under this section in the 2010-11 school year and whose  
4 family income has increased, may continue to attend a private school under this  
5 section.

6 **SECTION 19w.** 119.23 (2) (a) 1. am. of the statutes is created to read:

7 119.23 (2) (a) 1. am. Beginning in the 2016-17 school year, the pupil is a  
8 member of a family that has a total family income that does not exceed an amount  
9 equal to 1.85 times the poverty level determined in accordance with criteria  
10 established by the director of the federal office of management and budget. The  
11 family income of the pupil shall be verified as provided in subd. 1. b. A pupil  
12 attending a private school under this section whose family income increases above  
13 the income level in this subd. 1. am. may continue to attend a private school under  
14 this section.”.
