**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5,
TO SENATE BILL 21**

July 8, 2015 - Offered by Representatives ZAMARRIPA, BARCA, SUBECK, POPE,
HESSELBEIN, SINICKI and JORGENSEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** At the appropriate places, insert all of the following:

4 “**SECTION 1856x.** 118.60 (7) (h) of the statutes is created to read:

5 118.60 (7) (h) 1. Each private school participating in the program under this
6 section shall annually conduct state and federal background checks of all teachers
7 and administrators employed by the private school on the effective date of this
8 subdivision [LRB inserts date].

9 2. Beginning on the effective date of this subdivision [LRB inserts date],
10 each private school participating in the program under this section shall annually
11 conduct state and federal background checks of each individual who applies to teach
12 in or serve as an administrator of the private school prior to extending an offer of
13 employment to that individual.

1 3. A participating private school may not employ a person as a teacher or
2 administrator or contract with the person to serve as a teacher or administrator if
3 the person would not be eligible to be employed, licensed, or permitted for any of the
4 reasons specified under s. 115.31 (2g) or (6m) or 115.315.
