July 8, 2015 - Offered by Representatives POPE, GENRICH, SINICKI and CONSIDINE.

6	in a parental choice program, conceal or fail to disclose that event with an intent to
7	fraudulently participate in a parental choice program.
8	(b) Receive a payment under a parental choice program and use the funding
9	for purposes that are not authorized under the parental choice program.
10	(c) Whoever violates par. (a) or (b) is subject to the following penalties:
11	1. If the value of the payment that is obtained as the result of the violation is
12	more than \$5,000 but does not exceed \$10,000, a Class H felony.
13	2. If the value of the payment that is obtained as the result of the violation is
14	more than \$10,000, a Class G felony.

16	parental choice program is considered to have made an admission as to the existence,
17	correctness, or validity of any fact stated. Such a statement is prima facie evidence
