**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4,
TO SENATE BILL 44**

March 5, 2015 - Offered by Representatives KAHL, BARCA, BARNES, BERCEAU, BILLINGS, BOWEN, BROSTOFF, CONSIDINE, DANOU, DOYLE, GOYKE, HEBL, HESSELBEIN, HINTZ, JOHNSON, JORGENSEN, KESSLER, KOLSTE, MASON, MEYERS, MILROY, OHNSTAD, POPE, RIEMER, SARGENT, SHANKLAND, SINICKI, SPREITZER, STUCK, SUBECK, C. TAYLOR, WACHS, YOUNG, ZAMARRIPA and ZEPNICK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: after “to a labor organization” insert “, funding for the
3 technical college training program, making an appropriation,”.

4 **2.** Page 5, line 8: after that line insert:

5 **“SECTION 12m. Fiscal changes.**

6 (1) TECHNICAL COLLEGE SKILLS TRAINING PROGRAM. In the schedule under section
7 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the technical college system board
8 under section 20.292 (1) (f) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2015, the dollar
9 amount is increased by \$40,000,000 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in
10 which this subsection takes effect to increase funding for skills training for workers.
11 In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the
12 technical college system board under section 20.292 (1) (f) of the statutes, as affected
13 by the acts of 2015, the dollar amount is increased by \$40,000,000 for the second

1 fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect to increase
2 funding for skills training for workers.”.

3 **3.** Page 5, line 12: after that line insert:

4 **“SECTION 14m. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after
5 publication, except as follows:

6 (1) TECHNICAL COLLEGE SKILLS TRAINING PROGRAM. The treatment of SECTION 12m
7 of this act takes effect on the day after publication, or on the 2nd day after publication
8 of the 2015-17 biennial budget act, whichever is later.”.
