**SENATE AMENDMENT 3,
TO SENATE BILL 449**

February 9, 2016 – Offered by Senators LASSA, HANSEN, CARPENTER, L. TAYLOR, C. LARSON, RINGHAND, BEWLEY, VINEHOUT, MILLER, ERPENBACH and RISSER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 16: delete lines 16 and 17 and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 4m.** 118.191 (2) of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act 55,
4 is renumbered 118.191 (2) (a) and amended to read:

5 118.191 (2) (a) Notwithstanding s. 118.19 (7) to (9) and subject to sub. (8), the
6 department shall grant an initial teaching license to teach a technical education
7 subject to an individual who is eligible for licensure under s. 118.19 (4) and (10), who
8 scores at least 100 points on the point system under sub. (5), of which at least 25
9 points are from sub. (5) (a) 1. and at least 25 points are from sub. (5) (a) 2., and who
10 agrees to complete during the term of the license a curriculum determined by the
11 school board of the school district in which the individual will teach and approved by
12 the department.”

13 **2.** Page 2, line 19: after “(7) to (9)” insert “and subject to sub. (8)”.

1 **3.** Page 2, line 25: after “teach” insert “and approved by the department”.

2 **4.** Page 5, line 11: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 10m.** 118.191 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

4 118.191 (8) The department may not issue an initial teaching license under
5 sub. (2) after January 1, 2020.

6 **SECTION 11m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

7 (1) TEACHING SHORTAGE TASK FORCE. By July 1, 2016, the state superintendent
8 of public instruction shall appoint a task force to examine best practices and
9 evidence-based solutions to address teacher shortages and to make policy
10 recommendations about how to address teacher shortages in this state.”.
