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SENATE AMENDMENT 3, TO SENATE BILL 449

February 9, 2016 – Offered by Senators Lassa, Hansen, Carpenter, L. Taylor, C. Larson, Ringhand, Bewley, Vinehout, Miller, Erpenbach and Risser.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ **1.** Page 2, line 16: delete lines 16 and 17 and substitute: 3 "SECTION 4m. 118.191 (2) of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act 55, 4 is renumbered 118.191 (2) (a) and amended to read: 118.191 (2) (a) Notwithstanding s. 118.19 (7) to (9) and subject to sub. (8), the 5 6 department shall grant an initial teaching license to teach a technical education 7 subject to an individual who is eligible for licensure under s. 118.19 (4) and (10), who 8 scores at least 100 points on the point system under sub. (5), of which at least 25 9 points are from sub. (5) (a) 1. and at least 25 points are from sub. (5) (a) 2., and who 10 agrees to complete during the term of the license a curriculum determined by the school board of the school district in which the individual will teach and approved by 11 12 the department.".

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2. Page 2, line 19: after "(7) to (9)" insert "and subject to sub. (8)".

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3. Page 2, line 25: after "teach" insert "and approved by the department". 1 **4.** Page 5, line 11: after that line insert: $\mathbf{2}$ "SECTION 10m. 118.191 (8) of the statutes is created to read: 3 118.191 (8) The department may not issue an initial teaching license under 4 sub. (2) after January 1, 2020. $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 11m. Nonstatutory provisions. 6 $\overline{7}$ (1) TEACHING SHORTAGE TASK FORCE. By July 1, 2016, the state superintendent of public instruction shall appoint a task force to examine best practices and 8 9 evidence-based solutions to address teacher shortages and to make policy 10 recommendations about how to address teacher shortages in this state.".
