ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 18, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1

August 14, 2017 – Offered by Representatives Ohnstad, Stuck, Crowley, Sinicki and Mason.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows: **1.** Page 12, line 11: delete the material beginning with that line and ending $\mathbf{2}$ with page 13, line 18. 3 **2.** Page 37, line 13: delete lines 13 to 16. 4 **3.** Page 37, line 16: after that line insert: $\mathbf{5}$ "(6) ESCROW ACCOUNT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS. Any business that begins 6 7 operations in an electronics and information technology manufacturing zone shall 8 establish and fund a trust or escrow account with moneys sufficient to cover the costs 9 of mitigating any environmental impacts of the business operation, as determined 10 by the department of natural resources.".

4. Page 38, line 20: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
with page 40, line 14, and substitute:

3 **"SECTION 58c.** 281.36 (3r) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

4 281.36 (**3r**) (f) If a person participating in the in lieu fee subprogram is 5 mitigating a discharge into a wetland located in an electronics and information 6 technology manufacturing zone designated under s. 238.396 (1m), the department 7 shall identify and consider mitigation that could be conducted within the same 8 watershed as the wetlands impacted by the discharge and as near as possible to the 9 wetlands impacted by the discharge and may locate mitigation outside the 10 watershed only if the department determines that local mitigation is not possible.".

5. Page 41, line 16: after that line insert:

12 "(2e) All agencies of the state preparing a recommendation or report relating 13 to a major action in an electronics and information technology manufacturing zone 14 designated under section 238.396 (1m) of the statutes shall include a statement on 15 the environmental impact of the action as provided in section 1.11 (2) of the 16 statutes.".
