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ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 260

June 9, 2017 - Offered by Representative Kolste.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 7, line 1: delete lines 1 to 21.
3	${f 2.}$ Page 10, line 4: delete "health care professional" and substitute "nurse
4	licensed or permitted under ch. 441".
5	3. Page 10, line 4: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 17b. 446.02 (7) (a) 3. of the statutes is created to read:
7	446.02 (7) (a) 3. A physician assistant licensed under subch. II of ch. 448.".
8	4. Page 10, line 8: delete the material beginning with " <u>a health</u> " and ending
9	with " <u>professional</u> " on line 9 and substitute " <u>another person</u> ".
10	5. Page 12, line 11: delete the material beginning with " <u>health</u> " and ending
11	with "(7)" on line 12 and substitute "nurse licensed or permitted under ch. 441 or
12	physician assistant licensed under subch. II of ch. 448".

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6. Page 14, line 24: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
with page 15, line 4, and substitute:

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"SECTION 38g. Chir 10.02 (4) of the administrative code is created to read:

4 Chir 10.02 (4) The unlicensed person is a chiropractic technician, nurse 5 licensed or permitted under ch. 441, Stats., or physician assistant licensed under 6 subch. II of ch. 448, Stats.

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SECTION 38r. Chir 10.03 of the administrative code is amended to read:

8 **Chir 10.03 X-ray services.** A chiropractor may delegate x-ray examination 9 procedures to an unlicensed person only if the delegation is consistent with s. Chir 10 10.02 (1) to (3), the unlicensed person is a chiropractic radiological technician or 11 other person acting within the scope of his or her license, permit, registration, or 12certificate, and the unlicensed person has successfully completed a course of instruction comprising at least 48 hours and including the following components: 1314introduction to x-ray examination; physics of x-ray examination; anatomy; patient 15positioning; safety measures; machine operation; exposure techniques and 16 accessories; processing and dark room techniques; film critique and quality 17assurance; professionalism; recordkeeping; emergency procedures, summary; and successful completion of an examination on the content of the course of instruction. 18 19 The chiropractor shall comply with s. Chir 4.04 before delegating the performance 20 of x-ray services to an unlicensed person.".
