ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 506

November 9, 2017 - Offered by Representative Ott.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 3, line 12: delete "or correctional" and substitute ", jail, or juvenile detention".
 - **2.** Page 3, line 13: after "recruits" insert ", but not for department of corrections correctional officers. The standards shall relate to the competence and reliability of persons to assume and discharge the responsibilities of law enforcement, tribal law enforcement, jail, or juvenile detention officers. The board shall prescribe the means for presenting evidence of fulfillment of these requirements".
 - **3.** Page 3, line 18: after "status." insert "The standards shall relate to the competence and reliability of persons to assume and discharge the responsibilities of law enforcement, tribal law enforcement, jail, or juvenile detention officers.".
- **4.** Page 3, line 20: after "officers." insert "The board shall prescribe the means for presenting evidence of fulfillment of these requirements.".
