**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 766**

January 30, 2018 - Offered by Representative NEYLON.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: after "state" insert "; extending the time limit for emergency
3 rule procedures; providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures;".

4 **2.** Page 3, line 22: after that line insert:

5 **"SECTION 5g. Nonstatutory provisions.**

6 (1) The medical examining board may promulgate emergency rules under
7 section 227.24 of the statutes necessary to implement this act. Notwithstanding
8 section 227.24 (1) (c) and (2) of the statutes, emergency rules promulgated under this
9 subsection remain in effect until May 1, 2019, or the date on which permanent rules
10 take effect, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding section 227.24 (1) (a) and (3) of the
11 statutes, the examining board is not required to provide evidence that promulgating
12 a rule under this subsection as an emergency rule is necessary for the preservation

1 of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare and is not required to provide a finding
2 of emergency for a rule promulgated under this subsection.

3 **SECTION 5r. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the first day of the 7th
4 month beginning after publication, except as follows:

5 (1) SECTION 5g (1) of this act takes effect on the day after publication.”.
