**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 907**

February 20, 2018 - Offered by Representative NYGREN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: delete lines 2 and 3 and substitute:

3 "1g. Page 1, line 7: delete the material beginning with "continuing" and ending  
4 with "practitioners;" on line 9 and substitute "reporting requirements for certain  
5 credentialing boards related to opioids;"

6 1r. Page 2, line 2: delete that line and substitute "counseling; and making  
7 appropriations."."

8 **2.** Page 2, line 6: after that line insert:

9 "3m. Page 6, line 18: after that line insert:

10 "**SECTION 7d.** 227.01 (13) (zk) of the statutes is amended to read:

11 227.01 (13) (zk) Are guidelines issued under s. 440.035 (2m) (b).

1           **SECTION 7h.** 440.035 (2m) of the statutes is renumbered 440.035 (2m) (b) and  
2 amended to read:

3           440.035 **(2m)** (b) The medical examining board, the podiatry affiliated  
4 credentialing board, the board of nursing, the dentistry examining board, or the  
5 optometry examining board may issue guidelines regarding best practices in  
6 prescribing controlled substances, ~~as defined in s. 961.01 (4)~~, for persons  
7 credentialed by that board who are authorized to prescribe controlled substances.

8           **SECTION 7p.** 440.035 (2m) (a) of the statutes is created to read:

9           440.035 **(2m)** (a) In this subsection, “controlled substance” has the meaning  
10 given in s. 961.01 (4).

11           **SECTION 7t.** 440.035 (2m) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

12           440.035 **(2m)** (c) 1. The medical examining board, the podiatry affiliated  
13 credentialing board, the board of nursing, the dentistry examining board, and the  
14 optometry examining board shall, by the first day of the 7th month beginning after  
15 the effective date of this subdivision ... [LRB inserts date], and annually thereafter,  
16 submit a report to the persons specified in subd. 2. that does all of the following:

17           a. Details proactive efforts taken by the board to address the issue of opioid  
18 abuse. The board shall specify whether the board has required, or otherwise  
19 encouraged, continuing education related to prescribing controlled substances for  
20 persons credentialed by that board who are authorized to prescribe controlled  
21 substances.

22           b. Sets goals for addressing the issue of opioid abuse, as that issue pertains to  
23 or implicates the practices of the professions regulated by the board.

24           c. Describes the actions taken by the board so that the goals described in subd.  
25 1. b. that were identified in the board’s previous reports under this paragraph can

1 be achieved, whether those goals have been achieved, and, if the goals have not been  
2 achieved, the reasons therefor.

3 2. A report under subd. 1. shall be submitted to all of the following:

4 a. Any committee, task force, or other body or person designated by the  
5 governor.

6 b. To the appropriate standing committees of the legislature with jurisdiction  
7 over health issues under s. 13.172 (3).”.”.

8 **3.** Page 2, line 9: after that line insert:

9 “4e. Page 8, line 3: delete lines 3 to 12.

10 4m. Page 8, line 23: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
11 with page 9, line 17.

12 4s. Page 10, line 3: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
13 page 13, line 6.”.

14 **4.** Page 6, line 10: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
15 page 8, line 18.
