ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 923

February 26, 2018 - Offered by Representative Mursau.

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

- **1.** Page 2, line 1: after "board," insert "clarifying the duties of a county administrative coordinator,".
 - **2.** Page 11, line 16: after that line insert:

"Section 13g. 59.19 of the statutes is renumbered 59.19 (intro.) and amended to read:

59.19 Administrative coordinator. (intro.) In any county which has not created the office of county executive or county administrator, the board shall designate, no later than January 1, 1987, an elected or appointed official to serve as administrative coordinator of the county or, in the alternative, may designate as administrative coordinator any other individual who, based on the individual's training, experience, administrative ability, and general qualifications and fitness,

is qualified to hold the position. The administrative coordinator shall be responsible
for coordinating and directing all administrative and management functions of the
county government not otherwise vested by law in boards or commissions, or in other
elected officers. The powers and duties of the administrative coordinator may
include all of the following:
Section 13h. 59.19 (1) of the statutes is created to read:
59.19 (1) Communication of policies, directives, and initiatives of the board to
county departments.
Section 13i. 59.19 (2) of the statutes is created to read:
59.19 (2) Preparation or assistance in the development of the county's budget.
SECTION 13j. 59.19 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
59.19 (3) Preparation or assistance in the development of an annual report to
the board, if the board requires the preparation of such a report.
Section 13k. 59.19 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
59.19 (4) Performance of special projects and assignments, as directed by the
board.
Section 13L. 59.19 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
59.19 (5) Supervision of the heads of departments, if the board directs the
administrator to conduct such supervision and if such supervision is not otherwise
vested by law in boards or commissions, or in other elected officers.".
