SENATE AMENDMENT 3, TO SENATE BILL 108

June 14, 2017 – Offered by Senators Johnson, Vinehout, Carpenter, Erpenbach, Risser, Ringhand, Miller, Bewley, Hansen and Larson.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 3: delete "requirements" and substitute "requirements,
3	regulatory and practice updates for cosmetologists and related professionals,
4	cosmetology licensure exams,".
5	2. Page 2, line 1: delete that line and substitute:
6	"SECTION 1c. 454.07 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:
7	454.07 (2m) The written examination for a license issued under s. 454.06 (2)
8	shall include questions that require applicants to demonstrate knowledge of the
9	treatment of all hair types, and of hair straightening processes and the health risks
10	associated with hair straightening processes.
11	SECTION 1g. 454.12 of the statutes is renumbered 454.12 (1m).
12	SECTION 1n. 454.12 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

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1 454.12 (2m) The continuing education required by rule under sub. (1m) (b) 2 shall include training on preventing the spread of methicillin-resistant 3 Staphylococcus aureus and infectious diseases that have a reasonable risk of being 4 spread through the practice of cosmetology, aesthetics, manicuring, or electrology.

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5 SECTION 1r. 454.12 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

6 454.12 (3) Up to one-half of the amount of continuing education credits 7 required by rule under sub. (1m) (b) may be completed by informal, self-directed 8 learning activities, including reading, teaching, researching, serving on a board or 9 committee, viewing a video, listening to an audio recording, or participating in other 10 experiential learning activities that are determined by the examining board to be 11 relevant to competency to practice cosmetology, aesthetics, manicuring, or 12 electrology.

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SECTION 1w. 454.125 of the statutes is created to read:

454.125 Regulatory and practice updates. During each period between
license renewal dates under s. 440.08 (2) (a), the department shall send, by electronic
mail, to each person granted a license under s. 454.06 (2) to (6), a digest that describes
all of the following:

18 (1) Changes to statutes and rules that affect the practice of cosmetology,aesthetics, manicuring, or electrology.

20 (2) Changes and developments in the methods used in the practice of 21 cosmetology, aesthetics, manicuring, or electrology.".
