**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 48**

November 7, 2017 - Offered by Representative PETERSEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2 amendment 2, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 5, line 15: delete lines 15 to 19 and substitute:

4 “(a) The city, town, or village in which the water public utility provides utility
5 service to the property has enacted an ordinance that does all of the following:

6 1. Permits the water public utility to provide the financial assistance.

7 2. Specifies the water utility service classes of customers for which financial
8 assistance may be provided. The ordinance may only specify classes of customers to
9 which the water public utility provided service prior to the effective date of this
10 subdivision [LRB inserts date].

11 3. Prohibits the water public utility from imposing any eligibility requirement
12 on an owner or property other than that the property receives water utility service
13 in a customer class specified in the ordinance under subd. 2.

1 4. Requires each owner of a premises located in the city, town, or village that
2 is serviced by a customer-side water service line containing lead to replace that
3 customer-side water service line.”.

4 **2.** Page 7, line 6: delete lines 6 to 19 and substitute:

5 “2. If a water public utility in its application under subd. 1. intends to provide
6 grants as financial assistance, the commission may not approve the application
7 unless the grants satisfy all of the following:

8 a. Grants to an owner are limited to no more than 50 percent of the total cost
9 to the owner of replacing the customer-side water service line containing lead.

10 b. If the water public utility intends to provide grants as a percentage of the
11 cost of replacing the customer-side water service line containing lead, that
12 percentage is the same for each property.

13 c. If the water public utility intends to provide grants as a specific dollar
14 amount, that dollar amount is the same for each property.

15 3. If a water public utility in its application under subd. 1. intends to provide
16 loans as financial assistance, the commission may not approve the application unless
17 the loans satisfy all of the following:

18 a. Any loan provided may not be forgiven by the water public utility or
19 municipality.

20 b. If the water public utility intends to provide loans as a percentage of the cost
21 of replacing the customer-side water service line containing lead, that percentage
22 is the same for each property.
