**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 737**

February 7, 2018 - Offered by Senator DARLING.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 1: after “department” insert “or, if applicable, the county
3 department”.

4 **2.** Page 3, line 20: delete the material beginning with “, if” and ending with
5 “applicable,” on line 21.

6 **3.** Page 4, line 6: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 2m.** 51.14 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 51.14 (3) (a) A minor 14 years of age or older or a person acting on behalf of the
9 minor may petition the mental health review officer in the county in which the
10 minor’s parent or guardian has residence for a review of a refusal or inability of the
11 minor’s parent or guardian to provide the informed consent for outpatient mental
12 health treatment required under s. 51.61 (6). For a minor on whose behalf consent
13 for outpatient treatment was provided by the minor’s parent or guardian despite the

1 minor's refusal, the treatment director of the outpatient facility shall file a petition
2 for review of the informed consent on behalf of the minor. If consent of a parent or
3 guardian of the minor is not obtained during the 30-day treatment period as
4 described in s. 51.138 (3), the treatment director of the outpatient mental health
5 treatment provider shall file a petition to initiate review of outpatient health
6 treatment of a minor receiving treatment under s. 51.138."
