ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 128

October 14, 2021 - Offered by Representative Cabral-Guevara.

1	At the	locations	indicated.	amend	the bill	as follows:

- **1.** Page 1, line 1: delete "informed" and substitute "written".
- 2. Page 2, line 1: delete "50.373 (1)" and substitute "50.373 Pelvic examinations on anesthetized or unconscious female patients. (1)".
 - **3.** Page 2, line 3: delete the material beginning with "written and" and ending with "informed" on line 4 and substitute "written".
- 7 **4.** Page 2, line 7: delete "unconscious" and substitute "unconscious, except as provided in sub. (3)".
 - **5.** Page 2, line 7: after that line insert:
- "(3) A policy under sub. (2) may not prohibit any person authorized to perform a pelvic examination from performing a pelvic examination on a patient when the patient is unconscious, a pelvic examination is required for diagnostic purposes, and

- it would be detrimental to the patient to delay examination until written consent can

- **6.** Page 2, line 8: delete "(3)" and substitute "(4)".
