**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 366**

August 30, 2021 - Offered by Representative SWEARINGEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 1d.** 23.33 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 23.33 (1) (d) “All-terrain vehicle trail” means a marked corridor on public
5 property, in a highway right-of-way, or on private lands subject to public easement
6 or lease, designated for use by all-terrain vehicle operators by the governmental
7 agency having jurisdiction, but excluding roadways of highways except those
8 roadways that are seasonally not maintained for motor vehicle traffic.

9 **SECTION 1h.** 23.33 (4) (e) 3. (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 23.33 (4) (e)
10 3. and amended to read:

11 23.33 (4) (e) 3. During hours of darkness in the same direction as motor vehicle
12 traffic in the nearest lane unless ~~all of the following apply:~~ the all-terrain vehicle or

1 utility terrain vehicle is operated on a designated and marked all-terrain vehicle
2 trail or snowmobile trail, as defined in s. 350.01 (17).

3 **SECTION 1p.** 23.33 (4) (e) 3. a. of the statutes is repealed.

4 **SECTION 1t.** 23.33 (4) (e) 3. b. of the statutes is repealed.”.
