ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 41

February 7, 2022 - Offered by Representative PLUMER.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 3: delete "and making an appropriation".
3	2. Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 10.
4	3. Page 6, line 6: delete lines 6 to 17 and substitute:
5	"(3) (a) Before issuing the request for proposal, the department of
6	administration in collaboration with the departments of health services and safety
7	and professional services shall submit to the joint committee on finance the proposed
8	request for proposals described under sub. (1) and a request to supplement in an
9	amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 any appropriation of one of the departments.
10	Notwithstanding the specified purpose of any such appropriation, a supplement
11	under this paragraph may be expended for the purpose of financing the cost of the
12	opioid and methamphetamine data system. If the cochairpersons of the joint
13	committee on finance do not notify the departments within 14 working days after the

1 date of the submission under this paragraph that the committee has scheduled a $\mathbf{2}$ meeting for the purpose of reviewing the submission, the departments may issue the 3 request for proposals and the proposed supplement is considered approved. If, within 14 working days after the date of the submittal of the proposed request for 4 proposals under this paragraph, the cochairpersons of the committee notify the $\mathbf{5}$ 6 departments that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of 7 reviewing the submission, the department may issue the proposed request for 8 proposals only upon approval by the committee and the supplementation is subject 9 to the committee's approval.".

- 10 **4.** Page 6, line 18: delete that line and substitute:
- 11 "(b) At the time of the departments' submission under".
- 12 **5.** Page 7, line 18: delete "2022" and substitute "2024".
