**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 919**

February 14, 2022 - Offered by Representative SWEARINGEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 2: delete lines 2 to 6 and substitute:

3 “59.692 (1f) (b) 1. Allows the buffer zone to contain ~~a~~ an access and viewing
4 corridor that is at least 35 feet wide for every 100 feet of shoreline frontage. A county
5 shoreland zoning ordinance may not establish a maximum width along the shoreline
6 for an access and viewing corridor that is less than 10 feet or 35 percent of the
7 shoreline frontage, whichever is greater, except that the ordinance may not permit
8 the width of an access and viewing corridor to exceed 200 feet.”.
