**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 355**

July 15, 2021 - Offered by Senator JACQUE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 9: after “products,” insert “providing requirements regarding
3 the placement of cigarettes, nicotine products, tobacco products, or vapor products
4 by retailers.”.

5 **2.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 1m.** 134.65 (7) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

7 134.65 (7) (a) 1. The person has violated s. 134.66 (2) (a), (am), (cm), ~~or~~ (e), or
8 (f) or a municipal ordinance adopted under s. 134.66 (5).”.

9 **3.** Page 4, line 12: after that line insert:

10 “**SECTION 4m.** 134.66 (2) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

11 134.66 (2) (f) A retailer shall place cigarettes, nicotine products, tobacco
12 products, or vapor products only in locations that are inaccessible to customers
13 without the assistance of the retailer or the retailer’s employee or agent, including

1 behind the counter or in a locked case. This paragraph does not apply to any of the
2 following:

3 1. Cigarettes, nicotine products, tobacco products, or vapor products sold from
4 a vending machine.

5 2. A retail location that receives 75 percent or more of its revenue from sales
6 of cigarettes, nicotine products, tobacco products, or vapor products, if no person
7 younger than 21 years of age is permitted to enter the retail location without being
8 accompanied by his or her parent or guardian or by his or her spouse who has
9 attained the age of 21 years.

10 3. Cigars placed in an enclosed room in a retail location if no person younger
11 than 21 years of age is permitted to enter the room without being accompanied by
12 his or her parent or guardian or by his or her spouse who has attained the age of 21
13 years, the room has a separate system for controlling humidity, and the entrance to
14 the room is directly visible or visible by video surveillance from the retail location's
15 register or check-out area.”.

16 **4.** Page 5, line 17: after that line insert:

17 “**SECTION 6m.** 134.66 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

18 134.66 (4) (a) 1. In this paragraph, “violation” means a violation of sub. (2) (a),
19 (am), (cm), ~~or (e)~~, or (f) or a local ordinance which strictly conforms to sub. (2) (a), (am),
20 (cm), ~~or (e)~~, or (f).”.

21 **5.** Page 9, line 21: after that line insert:

22 “**SECTION 23m. Effective date.**
